Hello, thank you for doing this. My question is about health insurance for UN staff. Are they required to have GKV/PKV as Germany has a mandatory insurance requirement?

UN insurance (CIGNA/UNSMIS) is accepted. Other providers need to confirm that the coverage is equal to the German statutory health insurance.

Housing and settling in

Does Bonn provide some support for their apartment searching?

Can you provide suggestions of how to find temporary housing, beyond using Airbnb, booking.com etc? I am looking for potentially up to 1 month for my family until our long term accommodation is available.

Short-Term Serviced Apartments: Options include [Bonnox Boardinghouse & Hotel](#), [Living Hotel Kanzler](#), and private agencies such as Zeitwohnen [The Boarding House at Heussallee](#) next to the UN-Campus also offers fully furnished apartments at reasonable. Some research institutes (e.g., Caesar) rent short-term apartments to international staff if available.

For the UN colleagues: is there any discussion underway about reviewing the maximum rent limit that I understand is shared among UN Agencies? Timely given the significant increased demand for housing.

The ICSC carries out a survey for HQ duty stations every 5 years. The last one for Bonn was carried out in 2023 and the next is due to be done in 2028. From my understanding our colleagues in OHR continue to consult with ICSC if there can be an earlier review. We will post information on the rental subsidy as it becomes available on the relocation communities.

Other practical questions

We have information that there are some restrictions for opening a bank account for citizens of some countries. I am wondering if you have lifted this restriction for UN staff who are citizens of those countries? We have reported that some banks in Germany won't open a bank account if you are a national of certain countries.

We did notice some issues fairly recently and have taken up this issue with the banks and the relevant authorities. All parties hope those matters will be resolved soon. Bonn is taking this very seriously and we are working on this topic in a joint initiative with several UN agencies.

Can you please provide the contact details of a German accountant who speaks English and can provide information regarding taxes on US-based investments?

You will need a 'Steuerberater' that specializes in international tax law and double taxation agreements (search for 'internationales Steuerrecht' and 'Doppelbesteuerungsabkommen'). There are several in Bonn. The web lists JUHN, KW, BWLC, for instance.

However, I seem to understand this only applies to individuals moving to Germany under ordinary EU free-movement law instead of protocol status which is in this case the suggested route for UN personnel. Basically in this case, protocol status can actually reduce rights that would otherwise exist under normal EU residence law – and depend on how UNDP would structure the posting and immunities through the host country agreement. In this case, can we use ordinary EU residence rules (family reunification) instead at the moment of visa application for the non EU spouse? 35	United States	It is recommended that you apply for a work visa in advance, if you are PSA or expert on mission. If you are regular staff - you may enter just with your passport. Protocol ID will be issued. But please be advised that you can only start working after the protocol ID is issued

37	How's racial respect for diversity in Bonn? Are there schools which offer instructions in English?	I can assure you that Bonn is a very welcoming and international duty station. We have many expats from different cultures and nationalities. There might be the occasional incidence, but overall you will feel very welcomed here.
38	does spouse need to apply for work permit in Bonn to apply for job? how long does it take?	This depends on the Seat Agreement applicable to the respective UN organization.
39	How can we go about transferring our NY driver's license to a Texas license to facilitate getting a German driver's license as advised?	You would have to have legitimate standing in another state that is recognized by Germany, in this case Texas. If you have no standing in another state with a recognition arrangement with Germany, then I think you will need to clear the hurdles in Germany related to any driving classes and tests. There are a lot of driving schools around. They are called "Fahrschule." And while this may sound stressful, it is doable!
40	<p>According to the bonn.de website, In the case of foreign civil status documents, legalization or an apostille is required in addition to a translation. This depends on the country in which the civil status certificate was issued. If legalization or an apostille is required, this must also be obtained. Otherwise, the civil status certificate cannot be recognized.</p> <p>You can check which country requires legalization or an apostille on the website of the Federal Foreign Office. You will find the link to the website of the Federal Foreign Office under the tab "Forms and links".</p>	You can complete your registration without the legalization or translation of documents. They will be needed to register your civil status, but that can be done at a later point. From the City perspective, it is always advisable to make an appointment with the Citizens Service Center (see details in our login area) to avoid unnecessary steps.

42	For the UNDP HCA, will spouses have automatic employment authorization?	Under the current Host Country Agreement, based on the 1946 Convention, spouses are issued Protocol IDs, which generally serve as proof of their exemption from the requirement to obtain a work permit. However, for specifics around this issue, please submit your questions through UNall using the contact center. A subject matter expert from general Operations will support you on this question.
43	For the UNDP HCA, will spouses have automatic employment authorization?	The current administrative arrangements should be read as the operational guidance currently applicable to relocating UNDP personnel and their families. Where a spouse intends to work in Germany, the request may need to be submitted through the organization to the German Federal Foreign Office, and confirmation should be obtained before the spouse takes up employment. UNDP will seek to clarify this point further with the relevant German authorities to ensure that staff and families receive consistent written guidance.
