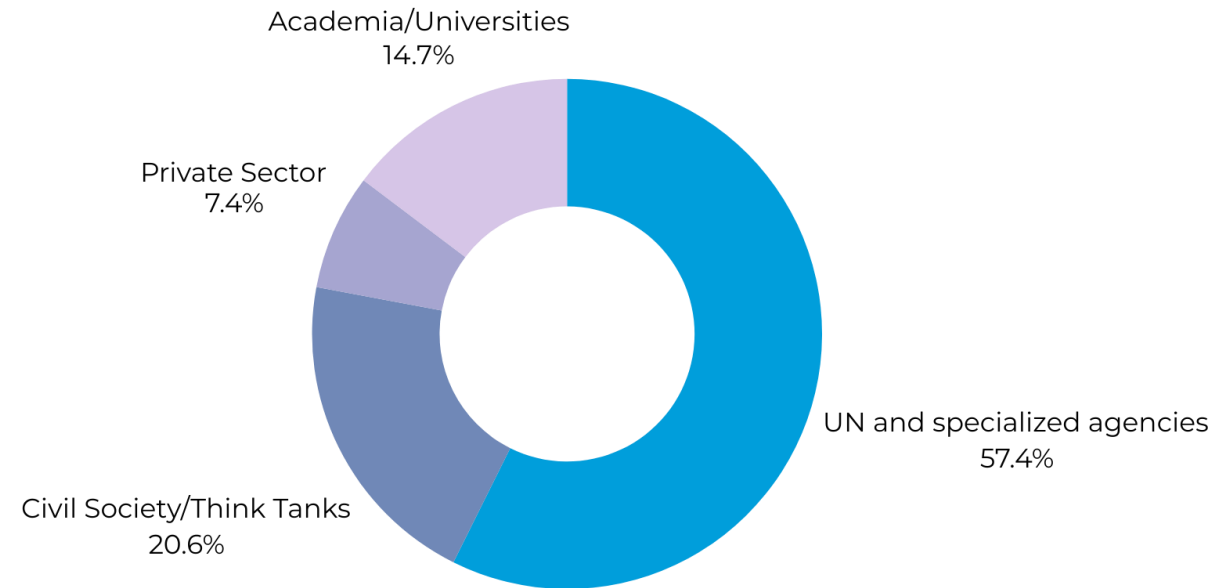

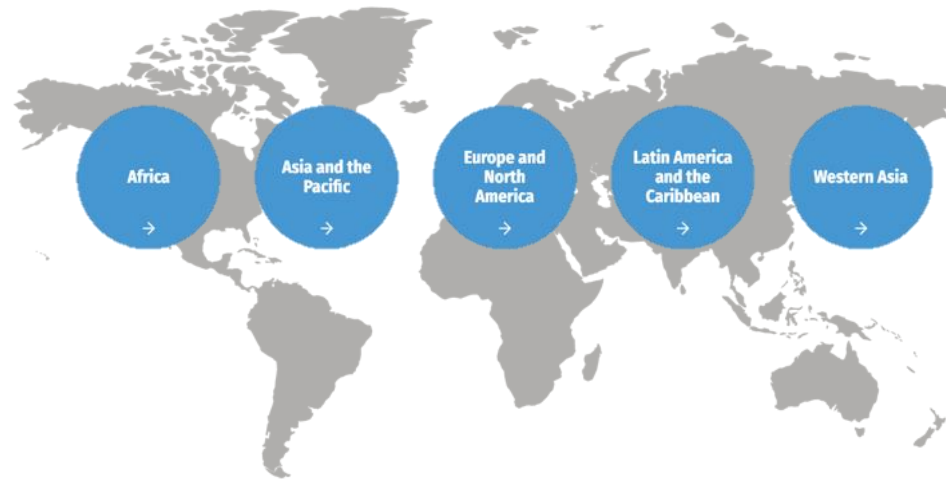

About the Women2Lead community

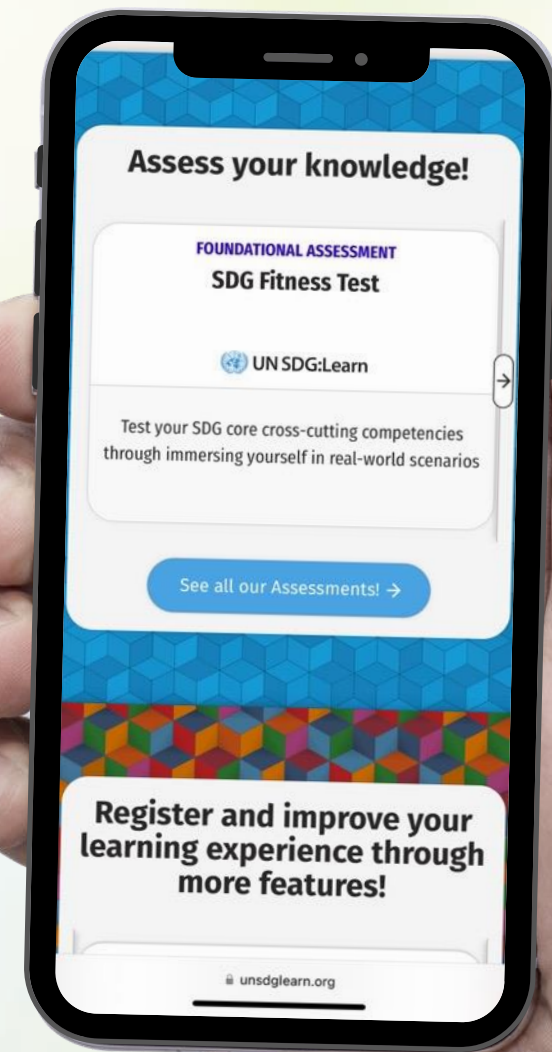
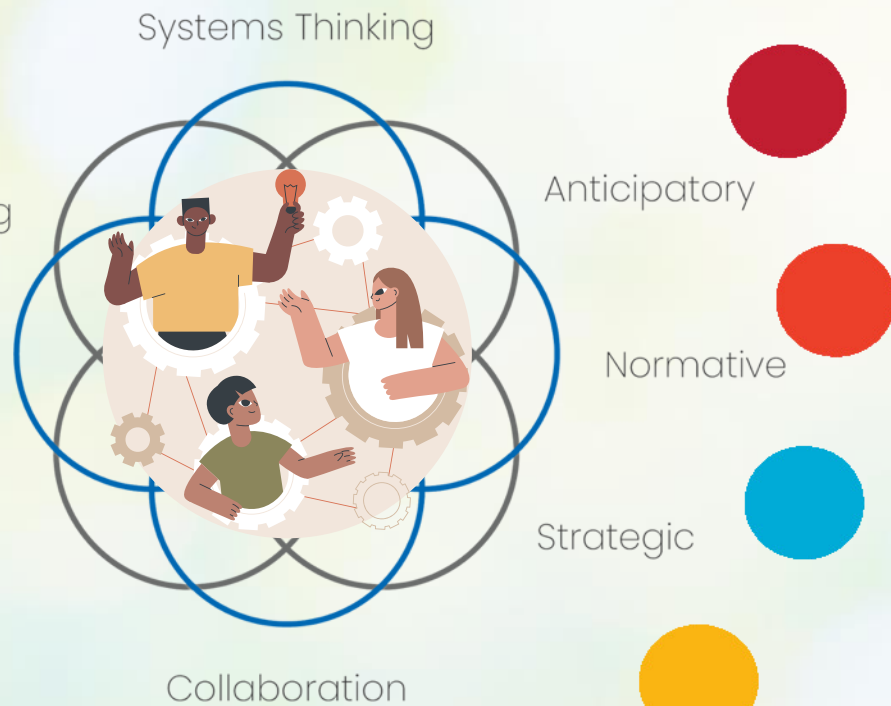
