The learning path is based on micro-learning modules, videos, and scenario-based learning.

The human security approach offers a practical framework to develop integrated policies and programmes to **prevent**, **mitigate**, **and respond to complex challenges** and their multidimensional impacts in a manner that is people-centred, comprehensive, context-specific, and prevention-oriented.

Social Protection for Sustainable Development

This interactive and facilitated course is designed for anyone interested in learning the basics of social protection and how to apply it through the lens of sustainable development.

Over **six weeks**, participants can learn how to champion a universal, life-cycle approach that addresses vulnerabilities.

By the end of the course, participants will be able to advocate for establishing universal, comprehensive, rights-based, and sustainable social protection systems in their country or regional context.
