The UNSSC's mandate from the General Assembly is to **enhance the capabilities of the UN system's personnel and stakeholders.**

UNSSC develops innovative learning solutions that address critical global issues. Our alumni report increased confidence in their ability to navigate ambiguity, lead teams and solve public policy issues in areas such as **sustainable development, climate action, peace and security and innovation.**

In 2024, UNSSC served over **66,000 learning participants.**

Over 90% of UNSSC total learners attend e-learning activities, which include **free online self paced and facilitated courses, online events and webinars.**

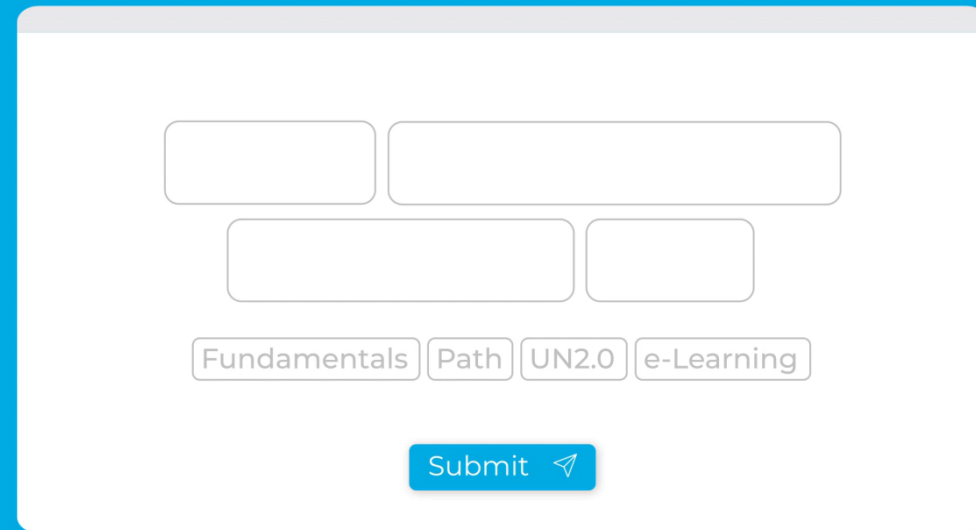
UN 2.0 Fundamentals E- Learning Path

The "UN 2.0 Fundamentals E-Learning Path" is designed to **strengthen expertise and culture to better support member states.**

It focuses on skills identified in the Quintet of Change: ***Innovation, Strategic Foresight, Behavioural Science, Data, Digital.***

The learning path is based on micro-learning modules, videos, and scenario-based learning.

Human Security: From Principles to Practice

This interactive training course is designed for anyone interested in learning more about the **human security approach** and how to apply it to the development of policies and programs.

The human security approach offers a practical framework to develop integrated policies and programmes to **prevent, mitigate, and respond to complex challenges** and their multidimensional impacts in a manner that is people-centred, comprehensive, context-specific, and prevention-oriented.

This **free online self-paced** course combines dynamic learning methods with a case study application broken down into **six easy-to-follow modules**.

Social Protection for Sustainable Development

This interactive and facilitated course is designed for anyone interested in **learning the basics of social protection and how to apply it through the lens of sustainable development.**

Over **six weeks**, participants can learn how to champion a universal, life-cycle approach that addresses vulnerabilities.

By the end of the course, participants will be able to advocate for establishing universal, comprehensive, rights-based, and sustainable social protection systems **in their country or regional context.**
