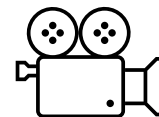
UNTold: fostering connections between the field and Headquarters



UNTold brings innovative best practices to life through compelling short videos and engaging virtual discussions. Since 2022, 12 virtual discussion sessions have drawn over 3,390 participants.

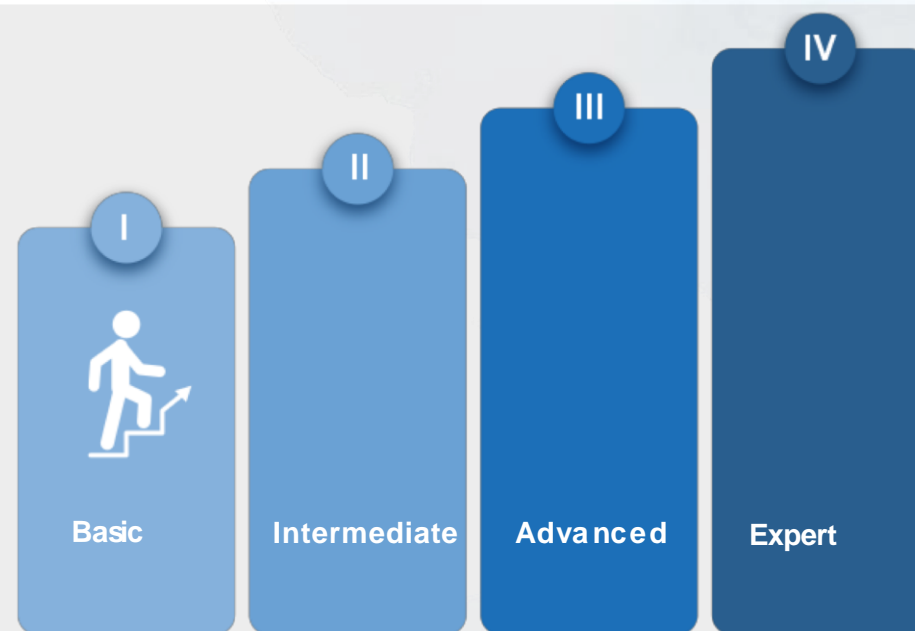
