 - Permanent positions EU civil servants appointed for an indefinite period. Candidates must successfully pass an open competition managed by EPSO. Once on the reserve list of successful candidates, they may be recruited by any EU institution.
 - 3 categories of officials:
 - AST
 - AD
 - AST/SC
 - Specialists:
 - Specialist profiles
 - Professional experience needed in most cases
 - Graduates and non-graduates
 - Grades: AD6, AD7, AST3
 - Competition timeline:
 - Application (notice of competition)
 - Tests (all online, in one day)
 - Reasoning skills test (in language 1)
 - Knowledge in the field test (in language 2)
 - Written communication test (in language 2)
 - Reserve list (if successful)
 - Timeline: 6-9 months
 - Non-permanent positions fixed-term positions as:
 - Contract Agent A wide range of roles in delegations, administration, support and policy. Most positions offer the opportunity to work in the European Commission for up to 6 years.
 - Temporary Agent

- You must be an EU citizen to apply; however, there are opportunities for local contracts in EU representations outside the EU. Local nationals may apply for "local agent" positions in EU Delegations, which are advertised locally by the respective Delegations in each country.
- There are 145 EU Delegations around the world, 43% are located in countries with difficult living conditions.
