Why this matters

- Organisational changes: UN agencies and international organisations are experiencing restructuring and funding constraints.
- Impact on professionals: Many dedicated staff members face unexpected career transitions.
- Need for support: There's a growing demand for guidance, insights, and encouragement during these pivotal times.

Who is a Career Pivot Ally?

A Career Pivot Ally is a professional who volunteers one hour per week to conduct up to two 30-minute informational conversations, offering:

- Career perspective: Sharing personal career journeys and key decisions.
- Sector insight: Providing overviews of specific fields, including trends and entry points.
- Qualification guidance: Clarifying valued certifications, skills, and experiences.
- Supportive presence: Listening with empathy and offering encouragement.

A short conversation can have a long-lasting impact. By sharing his/her experience, insights, and network, the Career Pivot Ally can help someone gain clarity, identify next steps, and feel supported during a challenging transition

What it is NOT...

To maintain clarity, the Career Pivot Ally role is:

- Not mentorship: No ongoing commitment or multiple follow-up meetings.
- Not coaching: Not a structured coaching session.
- Not recruitment: Not responsible for offering interviews or employment opportunities.
- Not counselling: Not providing extended emotional support beyond the single conversation.

Who can be an Ally?

Professionals from the public or private sector who are willing to:

Share their experiences and insights

- Dedicate up to one hour per week for two 30-minute conversations
- Support UN professionals exploring new career directions

Who is a Career Explorer?

A Career Explorer is a UN professional navigating career transitions who takes the initiative to reach out to a Career Pivot Ally



Benefits of being a Career Explorer



Gain insights: Learn from the experiences of professionals in your field of interest



Clarify goals: Receive guidance to help define your career objectives



Expand networks: Build connections that can support your career transition

Discover potential career paths and opportunities

How to become a Career Explorer

- Define your goals: Clarify the area, industry, or role you are interested in exploring.
- Update LinkedIn profile: Reflect your experience and interests.
- Identify Career Pivot Allies: Use LinkedIn's search bar and filters to find profiles with the #CareerPivotAlly hashtag.
- Reach out: Send a brief, clear message requesting a 20-minute informational interview.
- Prepare for the conversation: Practice a 5-minute self-introduction and list key questions
- Reflect and act: After the conversation, consider the insights gained and plan next steps.
